

REinit_{e.v.}, a non-profit association whose aim is to promote employment in Recklinghausen District, has more than 120 employees and scores of partner organizations in Germany. Since 1997 RE/init e. V. has specialized in the training and placement of disadvantaged and unemployed people in North Rhine-Westphalia.

Within the scope of the European Social Fund program "IdA," RE/init e. V. has launched **EU fit!** to integrate young jobseekers (18 – 30 years old) from Recklinghausen District into the German labor market. Through the exchange of knowledge and personnel, our mobility project enhances the employability skills of participants and improves their career prospects at home once they have been back from their vocational training in Ireland.

EU fit is divided into three consecutive phases (2009 – 2012), each one consisting of six stages:
